At St. Mary Parish the Rite of Confirmation is offered on an

every-other-year rotation. Preparation for the sacrament is joint-class program beginning in the fall of the 7th and 8th grade years and culminating in the spring. Thus, students eligible to receive the sacrament at the next scheduled date must begin the program <u>this fall</u>.

Students enrolled in a parish sacramental preparation program are required by the Diocese of Toledo to be *concurrently* enrolled in *general religious education* either through a parish Religious Education Department, a Catholic school, or a verified homeschooling program.

FR. BEAVER, MRS. MANCHA, & DR. MANCHA MEET WITH CANDIDATES—To Ascertain Readiness

Per diocesan requirement, each student is required to meet for a private, pre-scheduled conference with either Fr. Beaver, Mrs. Mancha, or Dr. Mancha. These one-on-one meetings are for the purpose of determining the candidate's readiness for the sacrament (and therefore the completion of his/her initiation into the Church). Interview sign-up will take place at the Sept. 23th meeting. Interviews will be Saturday and Sunday, March 2 & 3. Students should reflect upon and be ready to discuss their...
